This year's missionary month theme reflects the spirit of the Great Jubilee of Hope, ongoing since December 2024. Its highlight will be World Mission Day on Sunday, October 19.

We are called to be missionaries of hope, following Jesus who "went about doing good and healing all" (Acts 10:38) and who proclaimed liberty and healing (Luke 4:18-19). Amid today's global challenges—conflicts, climate crisis, migration, and human suffering—we are invited to be signs of hope.

Pope Francis in his message for the day (which he prepared some time ago before passing away), invites us to revive our hope, and be assured that God is with us! There is need of 1. reawakening our hope, (Lk 17:5) Lord increase our faith, the main message of the 1st Sunday of October; 2. taking care of our hope, (Lk 17:16) the 2nd Sunday of October, 3. sustaining our hope (Lk 18:8) 3rd Sunday of October and 4. being artisan of hope (Lk 18:14) 4th Sunday of October. He assures us I am with you to sow seeds of hope. He will never abandon us.

May all members of the Church: children, youth, adults, and the elderly, take part in Christ's mission through prayer, witness, sacrifice, and support for missionaries who bring the Gospel to all peoples. **Amen**
