THE FEAST OF ALL SAINTS brings to our minds and heart the infinite love of God the Father who created us as the image of His Son and called us to be his holy sons and daughters.

We will never be able to deepen into the infinite love of God the Father and His plan when creating us. To be able to walk in the path of holiness we need to have access to that "Plan", to see "the Face of God". St Philip asked Jesus to "show us your Father and we shall be satisfied". Jesus answered: "Philip, the one who sees me sees my Father". That is the sign of holiness: to be like Jesus and being like Him to be like the Father. Jesus showed us the way of holiness: to do the will of the Father, that is to be like Him, that is to be Saints. At the same time people will ask us "Show to us the face of Christ". And every one of us believing in Christ should be ready to answer joyfully: "The one who sees me sees Christ and through Him sees the Father."

Majority of the Saints dedicated their lives to Christ trying to be like Him, as the Father revealed and asked us saying, "This is my beloved Son, listen to Him", Jesus showed us the way to holiness proclaiming the BEATITUDES as the programme of a holy life. (*the Gospel of the feast*).

In our search for holiness let each of us try to be a "new" saint, according to our personal being and style. Let us add our holiness to the multitude of saints of different nations, tribes, culture, language expressed on the Book of Revelation. To imitate the saints is great but to be a "new saint is greater". Holiness along the history has different styles and characteristics but all of them have a common denomination: faithfulness & Love to God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit and love to all God's creatures, especially to mankind.

In all this process of holiness, the Holy Spirit is the transforming person of the Trinity, He is always in action, without Him we could not relate to the Father calling Him "Abba", we could not know and love His Son.

Let us pray the Holy Spirit guides us to know and love Jesus and through Him, know God the Father. Only then shall we be satisfied and our life be wholly fulfilled. **Amen.**
