A mission was established in Union Street in the year 1849 by Rev. Fr. George Bampfield, and was given the name **Mary Immaculate and St Gregory the Great.**

It should be remembered that, apart from our church, he also established missions at Cheshunt and St Albans. What is very interesting is that he gave this name five years before the Church declared the Dogma of the Immaculate Conception and nine years before Our Lady told Bernadette in the Lourdes Grotto that she was the Immaculate Conception! What a great name we have!

Celebrating the jubilee of 175 years is a significant milestone. We need to rewind the history.

First of all, we thank God for the gift of faith and for the many sacrifices our senior brothers and sisters made. What we are today is due to their witness, commitment, and love for Christ. They transmitted their faith to other generations with simplicity and love. How many priests, nuns, catechists, volunteers and committed lay people have loved their faith, and continue to do so

It is also a responsibility for us to keep our faith alive. We need to transmit our faith not only to future generations but also to many brothers and sisters among us who do not know who Christ is.

The community started as a mission and grew into a parish. Faithful to its call, it is reminded to go and proclaim the Good News, that is, from mission to Mission. **St Joseph Allamano, the founder of the Consolata Missionaries, whose jubilee is also now**, reminds us with St Paul: *Woe to me if I don't proclaim the Gospel.* Let us ask God that we may deepen our faith, renew ourselves, and participate actively in the mission of the Church: to evangelise. **Amen**
