The Most Holy Trinity

The Most Holy Trinity

Readings: (1st: Prov 8, 22-33; Ps: 8, 4-9; 2nd: Rom 5, 1-5 Gos: Jn 16, 12-15)

We celebrate today one of the most important mysteries of our Christian faith: the Feast of the Holy Trinity. There is one God in three Persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. The three are one. This is not something to be understood by the mind alone, but by faith. 1 + 1 + 1 = 1. Traditional logic fails us, for the three Persons exist for one another.

The Trinity is central to our Christian life. In fact, all our prayers begin in the name of the Holy Trinity. The same applies to our sacraments: what we celebrate is done in the name of the Holy Trinity. The Mass begins in the name of the Holy Trinity and concludes with a blessing in that name. When we bless ourselves or make the sign of the cross, we do so in the name of the Holy Trinity.

God has revealed Himself to us in this way. At the Annunciation, God the Father sends His angel to Mary; the Holy Spirit comes upon her, the Power of the Most High overshadows her, and God the Son becomes incarnate in her womb. The same is true at Baptism: the Son receives baptism, the voice of the Father is heard, and the Holy Spirit descends upon Him. Finally, at the Ascension, Jesus gives the missionary command: “Go and baptise them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.”

The three Persons are intimately united and are in relationship—none exists without the others. They are distinct yet one. May today’s feast help us to love the Most Holy Trinity and to strengthen our relationships despite our differences: in our families, workplaces, and with our neighbours. **Amen**

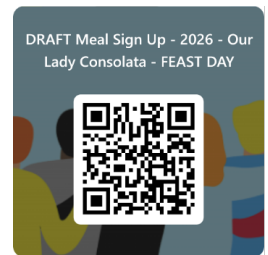
