Dear Parishioners,

After days of novenas and retreats, the long-awaited day has finally arrived: the feast of our Mother, Our Lady Consolata. She is the foundress of the Consolata Missionaries—priests, sisters, and brothers scattered throughout the world to bring consolation to God's people. It is also a feast celebrated in communities worldwide where, through the ministry of the Consolata Missionaries, people experience God's divine compassion.

Yes, she is the true foundress. The one who desired the existence of the Consolata Missionaries was not St. Joseph Allamano, but Our Lady herself. It is for this reason that we are called *Consolata Missionaries* and not *Allamano Missionaries*. The Institute came into being through the will of the Consolata. As St. Joseph Allamano reminded us, we bear the title of the Consolata as both our first name and our last name. The Congregation is her work. Therefore, the Solemnity of the Consolata is our feast, and in a very special way, it is our own feast (cf. Constitutions 2 and 11).

The relationship between Our Lady and St. Joseph Allamano was a unique one. From his seminary years, he had a profound devotion to Our Lady Consolata. His motto was: "Everything for Jesus, nothing without Mary!" His forty-six years as Rector of the Consolata Shrine deepened this devotion even further. How many graces and miracles did he witness through the intercession of Our Lady Consolata!

This year, we celebrate the feast of Our Lady for the second time here in Barnet. Indeed, our Mother never abandons her people. She is with us as she was with the early Church, and with her maternal love she continues to accompany us, just as she accompanied the disciples in the Upper Room. We read in the Acts of the Apostles that the apostles and other women were gathered together, among them Mary, the Mother of Jesus (Acts 1:13–14). It is consoling to know that our Mother never leaves us alone.

In a world still marked by contradictions, suffering, trials, and wars, may we continue to experience her protection as she shelters us beneath her mantle.

As we celebrate this feast during the double Jubilee of our community and the centenary of St. Joseph Allamano's birth into Heaven, let us pray for our community, that we may respond generously to our Christian vocation—a vocation that calls us to be missionaries, sent forth to proclaim the Gospel. May we become a credible community, full of life and missionary zeal. Let us also pray for all Consolata Missionaries, that they may continue to proclaim the Good News with dedication, fidelity, and generosity.

May Our Lady Consolata continue to intercede for us and guide us always. Happy Feast of Our Lady Consolata.
